- Use lightweight tiffin box, pencil box and water bottle to reduce the bag weight.










National Curriculum Framework for School Education 2023

The National Curriculum Framework (NCF) offers direction for educational planning and progress at all levels, from pre-primary to higher secondary education.

### **VIDHYAPRAVESH**

For observing the Holistic Progress of children, we must ensure that:

- The child should be between age 6 and 7 when they enter the Vidya Pravesh (Grade 1).
- ❖ 12 weeks / 3 months training is required for the students.
- First two months we provide play based learning.
- Grades 1 & 2 should have Formative Assessment instead of Summative Assessment.




Children will be assessed through various activities & worksheets on a regular basis given in the classroom.

- \*Assessment of children on all the essential aspects of their growth and development will be compiled in the form of a Holistic Progress Card.
- **\*HPC** is participatory, Inclusive, and based on learner centric approach.
- **\*Based on the observation, the child's progress of learning at different levels: Beginner, Progressive, and Proficiency levels will be assessed.**






